The calm waters of Rocky Point provide a comfortable and safe environment for first-time paddlers. Rocky Point Park is an excellent location for your school group's day trip offering many amenities within the park to complement the paddling activities. We can also provide kayak rentals for your groups to explore the Inlet with their teachers or other qualified supervision. We follow strict, industry safety standards and all of our instructors are certified by Paddle Canada and have many years of experience teaching and guiding sea kayaking.

2.5 hour Guided Inlet Tours

This guided paddle is a relaxed exploration of Burrard Inlet and the Shoreline around Rocky Point Park. Our guides will educate your students about the local history, environmental features of the Inlet and the local businesses that share our port. Just a short paddle from our shop within this rich marine environment, you will view hundreds of harbour seals, eagles, osprey and other wildlife.

Kayak & SUP (Stand Up Paddleboard)

Students are split into two groups. One group will venture out in double kayaks for an Inlet tour and basic kayak instruction. The other, will get on wetsuits and learn the basics of SUP skills and safety. In the afternoon, the groups will switch activities. All students must participate in both kayaking and SUP.

Customized Year-end Parties

Policies

- All participants must have a signed waiver.
- 7 days notice is required for cancellations, penalties apply for cancellations within the 7 days prior to the reservation.
- Final participant numbers must be confirmed at least 48 hours prior to scheduled program.
- Each participant must provide Rocky Point Kayak with a signed copy of our waiver by their parent or guardian. Waivers are available on our website.

Frequently Asked Questions

What if it rains?

Programs run rain or shine. However; we want your group to have a positive experience and safety is our primary concern. Rocky Point Kayak reserves the right to cancel programs if weather conditions are assessed to be hazardous.

What about safety gear?

Rocky Point Kayak provides all participants with the necessary safety gear including a PFD. All of our instructors are Paddle Canada certified and have the appropriate first-aid certification.

What should we wear & bring?

Do NOT wear cotton! Wear layers of breathable, quick drying fabric, and a layer of rain gear and pack a hat and water bottle. It is never a bad idea to pack an extra change of clothes as this is a water sport! Heeled sandals, water shoes or old sports shoes are the best choice for footwear. Please remind your group to not bring valuables or electronics.

What is the RPK guide-to-boat ratio?

The industry standard guide-to-boat ratio is 1 guide for every 6 kayakers.

What should I do before our group arrives?

Let us know the precise number in your group 48 hours prior to your program. This will allow us to arrange the correct number of guides and boats for your group.

Where can my students store their gear while we are on the water?

We have limited space within our store that can accommodate students back packs, however, we ask that you keep your belongings to a minimum.
