Rocky Point Park is an excellent location for your school group's day trip offering many amenities within the park to complement the paddling activities. We can also provide kayak rentals for your groups to explore the Inlet with their teachers or other qualified supervision. We follow strict, industry safety standards and all of our instructors are certified by Paddle Canada and have many years of experience teaching and guiding sea kayaking.

2.5 hour Guided Inlet Tours

This guided paddle is a relaxed exploration of Burrard Inlet and the Shoreline around Rocky Point Park. Our guides will educate your students about the local history, environmental features of the Inlet and the local businesses that share our port. Just a short paddle from our shop within this rich marine environment, you will view hundreds of harbour seals, eagles, osprey and other wildlife.

Policies

- 48 hours notice is required for all cancellations and confirmation of final participant numbers.
- Payment is due in full on the day of the program.
- Waivers must be signed by all participants and brought to Rocky Point Kayak at the start of the program. Paddlers under the age of 19 must have their waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Cancellations within the 48 hour period before a program commences are subject to an administration fee. Full charges apply for no shows.

Frequently Asked Questions

What if it rains?

Programs run rain or shine. However; we want your group to have a positive experience and therefore, safety is our primary concern. Rocky Point Kayak reserves the right to cancel if the weather conditions are assessed to be hazardous.

What about Safety?

Rocky Point Kayak provides participants with all safety gear. All instructors are certified in first-aid and carry the necessary first aid equipment.

What is your instructor-to-boat ratio?

Our instructor-to-boat ratio is 1:6. Teachers DO NOT count as instructors and are included in total number of participants.

What should the students bring?

Students are responsible for their own personal clothing, rain gear and footwear. A change of clothes and footwear is highly recommended as this is a water sport! Please let your group know to leave all valuables and electronics at home.

What can I organize before our arrival?

Let us know your exact group number 48 hours prior to your trip. This will allow us to schedule the suitable number of instructors and book the appropriate number of boats needed for your group. Your total numbers should include students and any supervisors.

What do we do when we arrive?

Upon arrival, our instructors will meet your group at the entrance to the Rocky Point Pier. Please ensure all waivers are completed upon arrival.
